Fast and Abstinence

Fasting: On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, those who are 18 but not yet 60 are allowed one full meal. Two smaller meals are allowed. Eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

Abstinence from meat: Those who are 14 years of age or older are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.

Almsgiving: CRS Rice Bowl Collection is the focus of Lenten almsgiving. This collection will be taken up on Good Friday.

Through fasting, almsgiving and prayer, the Church keeps Lent from Ash Wednesday until eve of Holy Thursday.

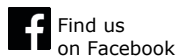
