Daily, from December17 until December 23, special prayers called the "O" Antiphons are offered. Each one highlights a title for the Messiah.

PROPHECIES

- I Rejoice, O daughter of Sion, and exult, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold the Lord shall come, and in that day there shall be a great light and the mountains shall bring forth sweetness, and the hills shall flow with milk and honey; for a great prophet is coming, and He will renovate Jerusalem.
- II Behold the One who is God and human shall come forth from the house of David, His ancestor, to sit upon the throne, and you shall see Him, and your heart will rejoice.
- III Behold the Lord shall come, our Protector, the Holy One of Israel, bearing on His head the crown of a kindom; and He will rule from sea unto sea, and from the river to the utmost bounds of the earth.
- IV Behold, the Lord shall appear, and the vision will not deceive; if that delays, wait for it, for He will come, and will not fail.
- V The Lord will descend as rain on the field; in those days shall rise justice and an abundance of peace; and all the rulers of the earth shall adore, all nations serve Him.
- VI A Child shall be born to us, and He shall be called the God of strength; Who will sit on the throne of David, His ancestor, and He will rule; in whose hand is all power.
- VII Bethlehem, city of the highest God, out from you shall go forth the Ruler of Israel; whose going forth will be as from the beginning of the eternal days, and He shall be praised in the midst of the universe, and peace shall be on earth when He has come.

Your eyes observed my smallest growth, and all was written in your book. Each <u>day</u> was formed before it came to be.


So precious are your thoughts, O God, and so vast is their sum. Were I to count them, I would never end; like sands of the sea, they cannot be numbered.


